What is a value?

And what is identity?

- Identitiy = a set of qualities, beliefs, personality raits, appearance and expressions that characterize a person or a group
- Identity = formed through heritage and experience
- Identity = shaped by social and cultural factors through life
- Identity = not a final product, but a process

Why do we need identity?

- Identitiy = a self regulatory structure
- Identity provides meaning, direction and self-control
- Identity fosters internal harmony, serves as a behavioral compass
- Identity enables orientation towards the future and the establishment of long-term goals

How is identity formed?

Values are the roots of identity

What are values?

- Values are "what is important in life"
- Values are the morals, the principle, the ethics, the code, the standards of our behaviour
- Values are our common heritage, they shape our culture

Which values define European Identity?

- Peace
- "The Union is founded on the values of respect for human dignity, freedom, democracy, equality, the rule of law and respect for human rights, including the rights of persons belonging to minorities" (TEU, Art. 2)

Which values define European Identity?

"These values are common to the Member States in a society in which pluralism, non-discrimination, tolerance, justice, solidarity and equality between women and men prevail"
